- D. Fire Department
  - 1. Has not yet received 2024 distribution check from Mikel.
  - 2. Generator
    - a. Will apply to Henry County Community Foundation for FD generator grant.
    - b. Gathering quotes for a unit
    - c. Consideration for annual maintenance costs also needs to be researched
    - d. CB would likely need a separate unit & can apply separately for a grant.
  - 3. LED lights
    - a. Duke has a 100% reimbursement program for replacement costs
    - b. FD electricity account is managed by the town, they may need assistance to file for the rebate program
    - c. Not sure if work has to be done by a licensed contractor
    - d. Gathering quotes for work
    - e. CB may want to consider the program too. Pickens offered to change lights at no cost to town (not as part of rebate program)
  - 4. FD has showers, washer, dryer & a few cots. It is considered to be an emergency warming shelter
  - 5. Township consolidation bill is not likely to move forward with the state.

  - 2. Partial payment can be made 60/40 split
  - 3. Pickens is still shopping plans
  - 4. Board voted to renew but keep shopping for better rates
